# Connected Pharmacy expected outcomes

- Discover and connect to shared purpose and agenda
- Work as ONE pharmacy team
- Improve your relationship across the networks and know who to talk to
- Improve service delivery / engagement (especially these that span across sectors) e.g Discharge Medications Services or New Medicines Service
- Improve patient care & outcomes through medicines optimisation and collaboration (e.g. digital)
- Support individuals through developing of key skills such as influencing/team working
- Reinvigorate individuals and teams as part of recovery
- Build confidence, support work and life balance, and increase resilience in an ever changing environment
- Identify, test out new ideas and learn from experience when responding to change
- Sustainable networks and projects with social impact that last after this programme
