# PSNC Elections - voting period extended until 31<sup>st</sup> March in the West Midlands

Please be aware that due to an error where independent pharmacies in Arden did not receive their voting notices on time, the voting deadline has been extended until 12 noon on 31st March across the West Midlands. The voting portal will remain open for all West Midlands voters until this date and the results will be announced on the afternoon of 31st March. The voting for all other areas will close on the scheduled day, 24th March, and these election results will be announced as planned on or around the 28th March. More on PSNC here.

### **Annual Complaints Report**

Each year, ending on the 31st March, pharmacies must prepare an annual complaints report. This year, rather than contractors submitting an email or paper return to NHS England, they will send out a Microsoft Form for all West Midlands Pharmacies to complete which will ask the same questions that are contained within the commonly used PSNC template. A link will be sent to all pharmacies at the end of the month, which will open on 31st March 2023 and the deadline to complete will be 30th April 2023. # Free clinical examination skills training

Health Education England (HEE) has announced a new NHS-funded training course for 10,000 community pharmacists on clinical examination skills. The training, which will be coordinated by HEE with the Pharmacy Integration Programme at NHS England, will be provided by CliniSkills. The training will be delivered online, with optional face-to-face attendance for pharmacists who would find this beneficial. # Reminder: Valproate audit data submission deadline approaching

By 31st March 2023, all contractors must have completed the 2022/23 national clinical audit on valproate over a sixweek consecutive period and have submitted their data via the Valproate audit 2022/23 tab on Manage Your Service.
