GP-CPCS

In February we had 982 referrals and 721 of these were claimable in Feb, 73% completion rate which may increase for some late Feb referrals.

In January we had 800 referrals of which 558 were completed, 70% completion rate.

Nationally the expectation is 90% completion **Action**

- 1. Complete any outstanding referrals
- 2. Clear old referrals from system
- 3. Ensure PharmOutcomes is checked at least three times per day

DMS

Our three referring hospitals – UCHW, GEH and SWFT are all referring into pharmacies through PharmOutcomes.

The numbers referred between April 22-Feb 22 are 546, 525 and 550 for UCHW, GEH and SWFT respectively.

However the numbers completed and claimed are significantly lower than expected.

- 1. Check you have fully process each stage of service once it is complete and marked it as completed.
- 2. Check for outstanding referrals on system and manage these

NMS

The latest NHS data shows that in October we completed **3,734 NMS** across **168 contractors**, averaging at **22/nms per contractor**

Over 30 contractors submitted zero claims for NMS in October

Blood Pressure Service

The latest NHS Data shows that in November **850 blood** pressure checks and **46 ambulatory checks** were completed across **41** contractors.

We hope in the coming months we see a new service spec with different urgent referral thresholds and RegTechs able to deliver the service.

Smoking Cessation Reminder

A set up fee of £1000 is payable through MYS to provide the service after pharmacy signs up and declares it has met the conditions of the service specification.
