Independent Prescribers: Pathfinder Programme

NHS England has, published information on its Independent Prescribing Pathfinder programme for community pharmacy, having this week sent a letter to all integrated care boards (ICBs) on this topic.

Information on a new Independent Prescribing webpage describes how the programme of pilot sites will operate. The central aim is to support and test different prescribing models to help inform and develop the framework for the commissioning of independent prescribing as part of clinical services in community pharmacy. An email will be coming out from NHSE West Midlands Hub Team (based in Solihull ICB) about the IP Pathfinder Programme detailing how to express interest via an online form. It will come to your NHS Shared email address.

Coventry & Warwickshire have been allocated 4 sites and these will be around respiratory – although support will be given to those who have an IP in another area but feel confident to cover respiratory as well.

Update: August Bank Holiday Pharmacy Opening Hours

We have updated the printable A4 sheet for pharmacies to display with a QR Code that links to a Google Map showing the pharmacies that are open on Bank Holiday Monday 28th August. You can download it from our website here.

Please remember that pharmacy premises must exhibit a notice, based on information provided by NHS England, at times when the premises are not open. Where practicable the notice should be legible from outside the pharmacy premises, specifying the addresses of other NHS pharmacies and the days on which and times at which drugs and appliances may be obtained from those addresses. A list of pharmacies is displayed on the NHS website here.

Pharmacy contractors are expected to have updated their own NHS UK and DoS profiles. If DoS Profile has not been updated, pharmacies will need to request emergency profiling changes by the DoS team by phoning **0300 0200 363**.

New Serious Shortage Protocols issued

<u>Estradot® 100micrograms/24hours patches:</u> SSP057 enables pharmacists to provide either one Evorel® 100 patch or one Estraderm® MX 100 patch as a suitable alternative when an Estradot® 100micrograms/24hours patch is prescribed. This SSP is currently set to expire on 8th September 2023.

<u>Jext® 300micrograms/0.3ml (1 in 1000) solution for injection auto-injector pen:</u> SSP058 enables pharmacists to provide one EpiPen® 300micrograms/0.3ml (1 in 1000) auto-injector pen as a suitable alternative to Jext® 300micrograms/0.3ml (1 in 1000) auto-injector pen. This SSP is currently set to expire on 15th September 2023.
