C-19 Vaccination Programme Update in CW

Please note new requirements below from the ICB regarding Covid Vaccinations:

1. Stock takes must be entered on to Foundry MINIMUM every 7 days. The more often pharmacies put their stock levels on to Foundry the more sensitive the vaccine quantities will be calculated going forward i.e. Update your Foundry stock levels after each clinic and the Targeted Deployment Model will respond. i.e. more stocktakes = more vaccines!

2. Do not open up calendar bookings until you have secured vaccines – if necessary, you will have to moderate walk ins if you have not been operating this way.

3. Check your vaccine deliveries on Foundry and not through the HW SVOC email

4. Coventry & Warwickshire ICB SVOC for all other queries outside the above is **cwp-tr.cwvoc@nhs.net** to which all enquiries should be placed and not via telephone since an audit trail of enquiries and responses is required.



Covid and Flu Vaccinations

We note that most pharmacies are very busy with vaccine administration, some with flu and others with both covid and flu. This year there is a big emphasis on co-administration - covid vaccination sites are required to offer a flu vaccination at the same time as the covid vaccination is given. Patients may have pre-existing separate bookings for flu jabs after their covid jabs - if they opt to have the flu jab with the covid jab then it is important to remind them to cancel their flu jab appointment if it is with a different provider.

Having such a good variety of locations for these vaccinations is very important for patient access and increasing the vaccination numbers in target groups year on year. If any difficulties arise, for example any suggestions that one site is superior to another for vaccination, then please flag these to us and we will raise this at SVOC. It is important we work well across the system to ensure both maximum uptake and good working relationships between surgeries and pharmacies.

Unplanned Temporary Closures Procedure

The current workforce pressures are leading to unplanned temporary closures that are beyond contractors' control. In these circumstances, if contractors follow appropriate procedures to mitigate the effects of the closure on patients, the public, the NHS, and other community pharmacy contractors, they should avoid breaching their terms of service.
